Studio Amuse

Studio [Amuse](#) is located in the old mediaeval town of Škofja Loka, where Anja Musek is creating unique wearable items (scarfs, bags, jackets and jewellery), home products (lamps, vases, vessels, pillows) and works of art under her brand name AMUSE. Anja makes everything by hand using an ancient technique called wet felting. She is well known for her signature 'clean' contemporary design using wool and other natural materials like silk, linen, ramie, flax and cotton.



Studio Urchic

Uršula Oitzl Magister works under the brand [Urchic](#), creating porcelain objects that connect people and foster a warm, welcoming atmosphere. In her design process, she places special emphasis on the essential quality of porcelain – its translucency – using it as a key expressive element.

Her work is driven by a passion for shapes, textures, and graphics, combined with subtle colour accents. These elements come together in both functional and decorative pieces, including cups, plates, vases, and jewellery.

TRADITIONAL LITTLE BREAD MAKING

Bake Your Own Little Bread

Experience the heritage of Škofja Loka and create your own honey bread ornament featuring a motif of your choice. At this workshop dedicated to making little bread, part of Slovenia's intangible cultural heritage, you will meet a master craftswoman who carves traditional moulds for *Loški kruhki*, Škofja Loka little bread, and learn about the imprinting process. Create your own little bread, a traditional symbol of love and abundance.

TEXTILE DESIGN

TEXTILE PRINT

Print Your Own Textile Souvenir

At this short textile-printing workshop, create your own bookmark, a keychain or a tote bag. You will learn a simple, yet creative stencil-printing technique for textiles. You will choose a design and print your own pieces. Each participant can make either three keychains, three bookmarks or one tote bag. The workshop is suitable for individuals, families, and groups, and is open to beginners and children.

Print Textiles and Brighten Your Home

Immerse yourself in the art of creating patterns on fabric using the screen-printing technique. Learn how a screen is made and discover the process of printing and fixing designs onto fabric. Using prepared screens, you will create your own patterns and make either a decorative cushion, a placemat, a pencil holder or a bread basket. The workshop is suitable for individuals, families, and groups. It is open to beginners and children.

WET FELTING

Make Your Own Felted Soap

A master craftswoman will introduce you to the world's oldest textile-making technique. Felting has deep roots in Škofja Loka's hat-making tradition. Wrap a bar of soap in layers of carded wool and, using warm water and pressure with hands, transform it into a durable, decorative and functional product. Felted soap cleans the skin effectively, helps remove dead skin cells and stimulates circulation. No prior experience is required; therefore, the workshop is ideal for beginners.

Create a Scarf Using the Cobweb Felting Technique

Experience the magic of the cobweb felting technique and create a unique fashion accessory that will become a lasting memory of your travels. Use the softest sheep wool and other natural fibres, combine colours and textures and create either a warm winter scarf or a lightweight summer wrap. The workshop is suitable for adults and children aged 12 and above. **Please note:** Participants remain standing throughout the scarf-making process. No previous felting experience is necessary, therefore the workshop suitable for anyone interested in wet felting.

Advanced Wet-Felting Workshop

Take your creativity to the next level with a personalised workshop designed for those who wish to create something truly special, durable, and technically more challenging. Choose from a range of advanced projects, such as handbags, slippers, intricate scarves, or a lampshade, or option to make several smaller felted items, including jewellery, decorative pictures, and similar creations. The workshop is tailored to your interests and skill level, allowing you to explore the artistic possibilities of wet felting in greater depth.

NEEDLE FELTING

Create Your Own Wool Heart

Feel the softness of wool fibres during a short crafting experience where you will create a simple heart from natural wool and, if you wish, decorate it with patterns inspired by Slovenian tradition. At the end of the workshop, you will take home not only your handmade creation but also a lasting memory of a creative experience. The workshop is suitable for complete beginners and is designed for individuals, couples, families, or groups. The recommended age is 9 years and above.

Create Your Own Wool Petruska Figurine

For those who would like a deeper introduction to wool and needle felting, this workshop offers a calm, guided experience in which you will create a wool figurine step by step. Along the way, you will learn the basic techniques of needle felting while developing a sense of form, patience, and creativity. The workshop is conducted in small groups or as an individual session, allowing for a personalized approach and more one-on-one guidance. It is ideal for beginners who would like more time for creating and a more immersive hands-on experience.

PORCELAIN AND CLAY DESIGN

Self-made Souvenir: Škofja Loka Impressions

In this short clay-design workshop, choose a simple item and transform it into your souvenir. You can select either a small plate or a decorative tile, both made using the slab-building technique, or a small cup created with the pinching technique. Imprint patterns inspired by Škofja Loka onto your chosen piece, add colours, and sign your creation. Due to the nature of the process, you'll have to wait a little while for your souvenir – once the items have dried, the master will glaze them, fire them and send them to your chosen address.

Any eventual shipping costs will be charged additionally.

Porcelain Serving Plate

Experience the translucency of porcelain in a workshop where you learn the technique of rolling porcelain, shaping with or without moulds, and creating a unique serving plate. Special attention will be given to the shape of the plate, which will be determined by its intended use and your own inspiration. You will create the final shape of the plate by adding, removing or imprinting material onto its surface, and you will also enhance the resulting textures with colours. Due to the nature of the process, you'll have to wait a little while for your souvenir – once the items have dried, the master will glaze them, fire them and send them to your chosen address. Any eventual shipping costs will be charged additionally.

Stoneware Picnic Bowls

Discover the art of assembling rolled clay slabs while creating a unique set of two or three small serving bowls. Special attention will be given to the shape and finishing details of the bowls' rims. Master will demonstrate various surface-finishing techniques such as adding, carving, and imprinting. Using one of these techniques, you will shape the bowls in your own unique way, and if desired, you may also create handles. Due to the nature of the process, you'll have to wait a little while for your souvenir – once the items have dried, the master will glaze them, fire them and send them to your chosen address.

PAPER MAKING

Paper with a Personal Touch

Discover the craft of handmade papermaking through recycling and create unique sheets of paper with your personal touch. You can experiment with different textures, use various colours, and make prints and impressions. Flowers, grasses, seeds, and similar natural materials can be incorporated into the paper. You will take your paper sheets home while they are still wet and dry them later.

GLASS DESIGN

Simple Pendant in the Tiffany-Stained Glass Technique

Are you drawn to the beauty and translucency of glass? Discover the basics of the Tiffany-stained glass technique and try your hand at glass cutting and grinding, copper foil application and soldering. You will learn about the characteristics of glass, the proper approach to working with it and safe material and tools handling. With the guidance of a master, you will create a simple pendant for a necklace that will become both a keepsake of your creative experience and a reminder of your newly acquired skills. The workshop is suitable for beginners and is designed for individuals, couples, families, or groups. The recommended age is 12 years and above. Closed-toe shoes are required for participation.

Create a Multi-Part Pendant in the Tiffany-Stained Glass Technique

Would you like to try glass cutting and grinding, copper foil application and soldering? In the Tiffany-stained glass workshop, you will learn about the characteristics of glass, the proper techniques for working with it and safe material and tools handling. Create a multi-part pendant that can be worn as a necklace or displayed as a decorative piece for a wall or window. The workshop is suitable for beginners and is designed for individuals, couples, families, or groups. The recommended age is 12 years and above. Closed-toe shoes are required for participation.
